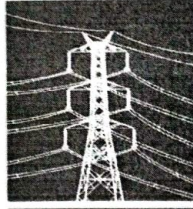

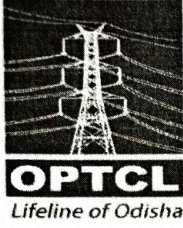

2. 8. Tenders will be submitted in person/by registered post with A.D. Tenders submitted by any other means shall not be accepted. Postal delay shall not be considered. Tenders received after due date and time shall be returned un-opened.
9. SECTION-III

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GTCC)

1.0 Scope of the contract

The scope of the contract shall be to supply of different power cables for commissioning of battery & charger at different Telecom Sections under Telecom Circle, OPTCL, Meramundali.

2.0 Definition of Terms

For the purpose of this Specification and General Terms & Conditions of Contract (G.T.C.C.) the following words shall have the meanings hereby indicated, except where otherwise described or defined.

- 2.1 "The Purchaser" shall mean the General Manager (Telecom.) for & on behalf of Telecom Circle, OPTCL, Meramundali.
- 2.2 "The Engineer" shall mean the engineer appointed by the Purchaser for the purpose of this contract.
- 2.3 "Purchaser's Representative" shall mean any person or persons or consulting firm appointed and remunerated by the Purchaser to supervise, inspect, test and examine workmanship and materials of the equipment to be supplied.
- 2.4 "The Contractor" shall mean the Bidder whose bid has been accepted by the Purchaser and shall include the Bidders' executives, Administrators, Successors and permitted assignees.
- 2.5 "Equipment" shall mean and include all machinery, apparatus, Materials, articles to be provided under the contract by the Contractor.
- 2.6 "Contract Price" shall mean the sum named in or calculated in accordance with the provisions of the contract as the "Contract Price" which shall include packing, forwarding, freight, insurance, GST as applicable at the time of opening of bids.
- 2.7 "General Conditions" shall mean these General Terms and Conditions of Contract.
- 2.8 "The Specification" shall mean the Specification annexed to or issued with G.T.C.C. and shall include the schedules & drawings attached thereto as well as all samples and pattern, if any.
- 2.9 "Month" shall mean "Calendar month".
- 2.10 "Writing" shall include any manuscript, type written, printed or other statement re-production in any visible form and whether under seal or under hand.
- 2.11 "F.O.R. Destination Costs" shall mean the cost of equipment and material at the consignee's stores. The cost is exclusive GST, but is inclusive of packing, forwarding and insurance and freight charges.
- 2.12 The term "Contract documents" shall mean and include G.T.C.C., Specifications, Schedules, Drawings, Form of Tender, Covering Letter, Schedule of Price of the final successful bidder any

special conditions applicable to the particular contract, Specifications and drawings and the purchase order & the agreement to be entered into.

2.13 Terms and Conditions not herein defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Indian Contract Act, failing that, in the Odisha General Clauses Act.

3.0 **Manner of Execution**

All materials supplied under the contract shall be manufactured in the manner set out in the Specification or where not set out, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Purchaser's representative.

4.0 **Rejection of Materials**

In the event any of the materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor is found defective due to faulty design, bad workmanship, bad materials used or otherwise not in conformity with the requirements of the Specification, the Purchaser shall either reject the materials/equipment or ask the Contractor in writing to rectify the same. The Contractor on receipt of such notification shall either rectify or replace the defective materials/equipment free of cost of the Purchaser. If the Contractor fails to do so, the Purchaser may:-

- (a) As its option, replace or rectify such defective materials/equipment and recover the extra costs so involved from the Contractor plus fifteen percent and /or.
- (b) Terminate the contract for balance work/supplies, with enforcement of penalty Clause as per contract for the un-delivered goods and with forfeiture of performance Guarantee/Composite Bank Guarantee.
- (c) Acquire the defective materials/equipment at reduced price, considered equitable under the circumstances.

5.0 **Deviation from Specification**

It is in the interest of the Tenderers to study the Specification specified in the tender schedule thoroughly before tendering so that, if any deviations are made by the Tenderers, the same are prominently brought out on a separate sheet under heading "Deviations".

A list of deviation shall be enclosed with the Tender. Unless deviation in scope, technical and commercial stipulations are specifically mentioned in the list of deviations, it shall be presumed that the **Tenderer has accepted all the conditions stipulated in the tender Specification, notwithstanding any exemptions mentioned therein.**

6.0 **Contractor to inform himself fully**

The Contractor shall examine the instructions to Tenderers, General Conditions of contract, Specification and the Schedules of Quantity and delivery to satisfy himself as to all terms and conditions and circumstances affecting the contract price. He shall quote price(s) according to his own views on these matters and understand that additional allowances except as otherwise provided therein will be levied. The Purchaser shall not be responsible for any misunderstanding or incorrect information obtaining by the Contractor other than the information given to the Contractor in writing by the Purchaser.

7.0 Patent Rights Etc.

The Contractor shall indemnify the Purchaser against all claims, actions, suits and proceedings for the infringement or alleged infringement of any patent design or copy right protected either in the country of origin or in India by the use of any materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor. But such indemnity shall not cover any use of the materials/equipment, other than for the purpose indicated by or reasonably to be inferred from the Specification.

8.0 Delivery

- (a) Time being essence of the contract, the materials/equipment shall be supplied within the delivery date specified in the contract. The Purchaser, however, reserves the right to reschedule the delivery if required. The delivery period shall be reckoned from the date of placing the Letter of Intent/Purchase order as may be specified in the LOI/Purchase order.
- (b) The materials shall have to be supplied within 45 days from the date of issue of Purchase order.
- (c) The materials/equipment shall be supplied at the locations mentioned in ANNEXURE-V.

9.0 Dispatch instructions

- (i) The materials should be securely packed and dispatched directly to the consignee at the Contractor's risk.
- (ii) **Loading & Unloading of Ordered Materials**
It will be the sole responsibility of the Contractor for loading and unloading & stacking of materials both at the factory site and at the destination store. The Purchaser shall have no responsibility on this account.

10.0 Contractor's Default Liability

- i) The Purchaser may, upon written notice of default to the Contractor, terminate the contract in circumstances detailed hereunder.
 - a) If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the Contractor fails to make delivery of materials/equipment within the time specified in the contract or within the period for which if extension has been granted by the Purchaser in writing in response to written request of the Contractor.
 - b) If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the supplier fails to comply with any of the provisions of this contract.
- ii) In the event Purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part as provided in Clause-10(i) of this section, the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase upon such terms and in such a manner as he may deem appropriate materials/equipment similar to those terminated and the Contractor will be liable to the Purchaser for any additional costs for such similar materials/equipment and/or for penalty for delay as defined in Clause-16 of this section until such reasonable time as may be required for the final supply of materials/equipment.

- iii) In the event the Purchaser does not terminate the contract as provided in Clause 10(i) of this Section, Contractor shall continue executing the contract, in which case he shall be liable to the Purchaser for penalty for delay as set out in Clause-16 of this Section until the materials/equipment is accepted. This shall be based only on written request of the supplier and written willingness of Purchaser.

11.0 Force Majeure

The Contractor shall not be liable for any penalty for delay or for failure to perform the contract for reasons of force majeure such as acts of God, acts of the public enemy, acts of Govt., Fires, Floods, Epidemics, Quarantine restrictions, strikes, Freight Embargo, provided that the Contractor shall within ten (10) days from the beginning of such delay notify the Purchaser in writing of the cause of delay, upon which, the Purchaser shall verify the facts and grant such extension as facts justify.

12.0 Extension of Time

If the delivery of materials/equipment is delayed due to reasons beyond the control of the Contractor, the Contractor shall without delay give notice to the Purchaser in writing of his claim for an extension of time. The Purchaser on receipt of such notice may agree to extend the contract delivery date as may be reasonable but without prejudice to other terms and conditions of the contract.

13.0 Bank Guarantee towards Security Deposit, 100% Payment and performance Guarantee

A Composite Bank Guarantee as per the proforma of the specification for 10% (Ten percent) of the total cost of the purchase order, shall be furnished from any Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank having a place of business at Angul, to the office of General Manager, Telecom Circle, OPTCL, Meramundali within 30 (Thirty) days of issue of purchase order. The Bank Guarantee shall be executed on non-judicial stamp paper worth of Rs.29/- or as applicable, as per the prevalent rules, valid for a period of 2(two) months more than the guarantee period mentioned at clause-18 for scrutiny and acceptance, failing which the supply order will be liable for cancellation without any further written notice. The said Bank Guarantee should be accompanied & should have provision for encashment at ANGUL, before the bank Guarantee is accepted & all concerned intimated. The BG should be revalidated as & when intimated to the successful bidder to cover the entire guarantee period.

- i) No interest is payable on any kind of Bank Guarantee.
- ii) In case of non-fulfillment of contractual obligation as required in the detailed purchase order/specification, the composite Bank Guarantee shall be forfeited.
- iii) The Composite/Performance Bank guarantee amount on the full order value shall be deducted from the first claim of the supplies made in cases where no Composite Bank Guarantee/Performance Bank Guarantee is furnished.

14.0 Import License

In case imported materials are offered no assistance will be given for release of foreign Exchange. The firm should arrange to import materials from their own quota. Equipment of indigenous origin will be preferred.

15.0 Terms of Payment

- i) **PAYING AUTHORITY:** GM (TC), Telecom Circle, OPTCL, Meramundali
- ii) **CONSIGNEE / VERIFYING OFFICER:** 1. SDO, Telecom Sub-Division, Meramundali of Telecom Division, Meramundali, 2. SDO, Telecom Sub-Division, Bolangir of Telecom Division, Bolangir, 3. SDO, Telecom Sub-Division, Burla of Telecom Division, Sambalpur, 4. SDO, Telecom Sub-Division, Jajpur Road, of Telecom Division, Jajpur Road.
- iii) **90%** of the contract price including GST will be paid on receipt of materials in good condition at desired locations and verification thereof, subject to furnishing and approval of guarantee certificate by the Purchaser. Balance 10% of the total contract price shall be paid after completion of guarantee period successfully and taking over certificate by the consignee. In case of non-fulfillment of contractual obligation, as required in the detailed purchase order / Specification, the retention amount shall be forfeited.

16.0 Price Reduction Schedule for Delay in Completion of Contract

(i) If the Contractor fails to deliver the materials/equipment within the delivery schedule specified in the contract including delivery time extension, if any, granted thereto, the Purchaser shall recover from the Contractor penalty for a sum of one half of one percent (0.5 per cent) of the Ex-works price of the undelivered equipment for each calendar week of delay or any part thereof. For this purpose, the date of receipted challans shall be reckoned as the date of delivery. The total amount of penalty shall not exceed five per cent (5%) of the Ex-works price of the unit or units so delayed. Equipment will be deemed to have been delivered only when all its components, parts are also delivered. If certain components are not delivered in time, the equipment will be considered as delayed until such time as the missing parts are delivered.

(ii) If the contractor fails to rectify/ replace the equipment/materials within 30days from the date of intimation of the fact, so noticed by the purchaser within the guarantee period then the penalty for sum of one half of the one percent (0.5%) of the total purchase order amount for each calendar week of delay shall be recovered by the purchaser within the guarantee period. For this purpose, penalty date will be counted from the 30th day from the date of issue of letter on defectiveness of equipment/materials, so supplied by the purchaser. The total amount of penalty in this case shall not exceed 5% (Ten percent) at the purchase order amount. If the defects so intimated is not rectified by the suppliers within the guarantee period then whole of the BG will be forfeited by the purchaser, without any intimation to the supplier.

17.0 Insurance

The Contractor at his cost shall arrange, secure and maintain all insurance as may be pertinent to the works and obligatory in terms of law to protect his interest and interests of the employer, against all perils detailed herein. The form and the limit of such insurance as defined herein together with the under-writer in each case shall be acceptable to the employer. However irrespective of such acceptance the responsibility to maintain adequate insurance coverage at all time during the period of Contract. Shall be of the contractor alone. The contractor's failure in this regard shall not relieve him of any of this contractual responsibilities and obligations. The Insurance covers to be taken by the Contractor shall be in the joint name of the Employer and the Contractor. The Contractor shall, however, be authorized to deal directly with Insurance Company or Companies and shall be responsible in regard to maintenance of all insurance covers. Further the insurance should be in freely convertible currency. Any loss or damage to the equipment during handling, transportation, storage erection, putting into satisfactory operation and all activities to be performed till the successful completion of commissioning of the equipment shall be to the account of the Contractor.

18.0 Guarantee Period

All the materials/equipment shall be guaranteed for satisfactory operation for a period of 1 year from the date of supply. Any defect if noticed during this period, the materials/equipment shall be replaced without any extra cost to OPTCL.

19.0 Payment Due from the Contractor

All costs and damages, for which the Contractor is liable to the Purchaser, will be deducted by the Purchaser from any money due to the Contractor under any of the Contract(s).

20.0 Contractor's Responsibility

Notwithstanding anything mentioned in the Specification or subsequent approval or acceptance by the Purchaser, the ultimate responsibility for design, materials used and satisfactory performance shall rest with the Tenderers.

21.0 Validity.

Prices and conditions contained in the offer should be kept valid for a period of 60 days from the date of opening of the tender, failing which, the tender shall be rejected,

- (a) In comparing bids and in making awards, the Purchaser may consider such factors as compliance with Specification, relative quality & adaptability of supplies or services, experience, financial soundness, record of integrity in dealings, performance of materials/equipment earlier supplied, ability to furnish repairs and maintenance services, the time of delivery, capability to perform including available facilities such as adequate shops, plants, equipment and technical organization.

22.0 Jurisdiction of the High Court of Odisha

25.0 Outright Rejection of Tenders

Tenders shall be outright rejected if they are not complying with the following requirements:

The power cable shall conform in all respects to highest standards of engineering, design, workmanship, this specification and the latest revisions of relevant standards at the time of offer and the purchaser shall have the power to reject any work or material, which, in his judgment, is not in full accordance therewith.

2. STANDARDS

Except where modified by this specification, the power cable shall be designed, manufactured and tested in accordance with the latest editions of the following standards.

3.5. Insulation Screening not required

3.6. Core Identification and Laying Up of Cores

3.5 core cables shall be identified by colouring of the PVC insulation and multi core by numbers as per IS- 1 554 (part 1): 1988

In multi-core cables, the cores shall be laid up together with a suitable lay as recommended in IS - 1554 (Part 1): 1988. The layers shall have successive right and left hand lays with the outermost layer having a right hand lay.

3.7. Inner Sheath

The laid up cores of the 3.5, 4 and multi core cables shall be covered with an inner sheath made of thermoplastic material (PVC) applied by extrusion.

The thickness of the sheath shall conform to IEC 502/IS - 1554: 1988. Single core cables shall have no inner sheath.

3.8. Outer Sheath

An outer sheath of polyvinyl chloride (PVC) shall be applied over the armour wires (where fitted). The sheath shall be embossed at regular intervals as per the Cable Identification clause of this specification and the minimum thickness and properties shall comply with the requirements of IEC 502/IS - 1554: 1988. The outer sheath for cables with general purpose insulation shall be of the type ST1 PVC compound and for cables with heat resisting insulation type ST2 PVC compound conforming to the requirements of IEC 502/IS - 5831: 1984.

The outer serving shall incorporate an effective anti-termite barrier and shall be capable of withstanding a 10kV DC test voltage for five minutes after installation and annually thereafter.

Cables shall be installed as a single four core cable or three single phase cables plus neutral in a close trefoil formation.

Current ratings shall be calculated in accordance with IEC 287 "Calculation of the continuous current rating of cables with 100% load factor".
